

# Welcome to our new community newsletter

The Coronavirus pandemic saw the Knighton and District Community Centre doors close in mid-March. Our weekly hirers have been hugely supportive and understanding during these times of uncertainty. We have re-opened to certain groups including education, childcare, health and well-being. Each booking is dealt with on a case-by-case basis; the Management Committee and PCC have final say. Our Tuesday Cafe Hub services are postponed; some professionals who would otherwise attend have made a contribution to this newsletter. We look forward to seeing these services return in the future, either in person or virtually. The Community Centre website and all our Facebook pages are regularly updated with information on local shops, businesses, services and has up-to-date information from the Centre and Library. The management committee are working hard with our cleaning staff to ensure that the Centre, while opening where we can, always meets the Welsh Government and PCC requirements.

The Hub has seen many wonderful people giving up their time to help others especially during this pandemic. From young to old it is simply wonderful. We have volunteers covering so many roles from acting as telephone befrienders for people who are isolated and alone to delivering lunches, baking cakes, making soups, marshalling events and generally helping out. Young volunteers find this helps immensely with college or job applications; we help them keep track of their hours and then they can use this on application forms which makes them stand out from the crowd.
